

Conduction of Two Exams by CBSE Board for Class X

CBSE has changed the examination pattern for the year 2026 and is going to conduct two examinations for the students of Class X; there are few points to be noted by the students and parents of existing Class X, in this regard:-

- ❖ 1st Examination Schedule as declared by CBSE –
Exam Schedule – 17.02.2026 to 06.03.2026
Result Declaration – tentatively by 20th April 2026
- ❖ 2nd Examination Schedule as declared by CBSE
Exam Schedule – 05.05.2026 to 20.05.2026
Result Declaration – tentatively by 30th June 2026
- ❖ It is Compulsory for all students of Class X to appear in 1st Main Examination.
- ❖ The result of 1st Examination will be made available in the digilocker of the students which could be used for admission in Class XI if the student does not wish to appear in 2nd Examination.
- ❖ 2nd Examination will be held in two different categories “Compartment” and “Improvement”
- ❖ Compartment exam can be given in maximum two subjects only.
- ❖ Any 3 out of 5 main subjects can be opted by the candidate for Improvement category.
- ❖ For appearing in 2nd Examination the LOC of students will be made live by the CBSE for the respective schools to finalize the names of candidates in both Compartment and Improvement category.
- ❖ All the candidates will be issued passing document after the second examination result.

School's Admission Policy in Class XI

As per our understanding of two examinations pattern for Class X the school has redefined the guidelines for admission in Class XI which the parent/students are bound to follow:-

- ❖ The parent may register his ward for the admission in Class XI only after the declaration of result of 1st Examination of Class X which is likely to be announced around 20th Apr 2026. They must carry a self attested photocopy of Class X Board Marksheet for registration.
- ❖ On the basis of student's result he/she may select a suitable stream out of 4 available streams and also one optional subject out of 6 available optional subjects in the prescribed **Registration cum Stream and Subject Selection Form**.
- ❖ In the same format parent may also opt for Day scholar or Boarder category as well as for optional Bus facility.
- ❖ The school also has Optional Competitive Exam (IIT-JEE/NEET) Preparation Classes (CEP) in association with Schoolip. The parent may also opt for this optional facility in the same format.
- ❖ The admission will be granted on the basis of *First come first serve basis* till the seats are available.
- ❖ Then the parents will have to deposit First Term Fee (2026-27) within the stipulated period of time. Fee deposited once will not be refunded.
- ❖ The students scoring 80% and above in Class X Board Examination (2025-26) will be eligible to avail a scholarship of 25% on Tuition Fee for their further studies in Classes XI & XII in our school (subject to consistency in performance of the student in Class XI).
- ❖ There is a provision of 10% sibling concession on the tuition fee of Second and third child of the same parents as long as the first child of the same parents continues his/her studies in our school. The candidates, who have confirmed their admission in school and have already paid 1st Term Fee in full amount their sibling concession amount (if applicable) will be adjusted in their II Term Fee. (Sibling Concession is not applicable to the students who are eligible for Post Matric Scholarship in Classes XI & XII)
- ❖ The students who have got compartment or are interested in appearing for 2nd Examination may apply only after the declaration of 2nd Examination result. The admission will depend upon the availability of the seats.
- ❖ The allotment of stream to such students will also be done as per the availability of the seats in particular stream.
- ❖ Stream or optional subject once allotted; with the consent of Student and Parents; will not be changed.
- ❖ Candidates other than CBSE Board can also apply for admission in Class XI provided they have a copy of Passed Marksheet of Class X Board. For them the rules and policy as per their board will be applicable.
- ❖ In no case admission may be granted without a valid Marksheet of Class X Board.
- ❖ School may provide relaxation or consideration in Attendance for some valid reasons.
